



SUMMER STIPENDS GRANT PROGRAM

Overview: Summer Stipends support individuals pursuing advanced research that is of value to humanities scholars, general audiences, or both. Summer Stipends provide \$6,000 for two consecutive months of full-time research and writing.

Eligibility: Full time faculty members, US citizens, foreign nationals (living in a US jurisdiction for the last three years), and not a recipient of a major grant (\geq \$15,000) in the last three years.

Limited submission: A panel consisting of five UNCG faculty will review, discuss, and recommend up to two proposals.

What to Submit: Submit a narrative not to exceed three single-spaced pages, a bibliography in one single spaced page, and a vita not to exceed two single spaced pages. You may also submit a one page appendix for Editions, Translations, or Database Projects, or for Proposals that Include Visual Materials.
